	<ul> <li>Communication: website, multiple social media platforms, newsletter</li> <li>Extracurricular: volleyball, golf, &amp; cross-country up and running</li> <li>Student Leadership: meeting and planning for the year</li> <li>QUESTION: Will grade 6s go to W.A.Day for "Wolfpack" activities? RESPONSE: Options are being discussed to have grade 6s either here or at W.A.Day. In addition, lunchtime intramurals are being discussed.</li> <li>QUESTION: Is it mandatory for students to wear masks in school? RESPONSE: Mask use continues to be voluntary for students and staff, but is supported for those who wish to continue with it.</li> <li>QUESTION: What will grad activities and ceremonies look like? How and when will information be sent to parents? RESPONSE: Grade 12s will be meeting as a class on Friday, Sept. 10 to discuss this issue and to collect parent contact information. LRSD Board Chair Lori Hodges	<ul> <li>School Division Update</li> <li>First official board meeting will be Sept. 21.</li> <li>Meetings and updates re COVID have been ongoing; check Irsd.ca website.</li> <li>QUESTIONS: Has the board had a discussion about the increase in numbers re COVID infection? At what point will the board re-implement a mask mandate? RESPONSE: Principals will be monitoring attendance re 10% mark indicating a change may be necessary. The situation remains fluid. Without contact tracing, we do not have all the information unless families choose to share with us.</li> <li>QUESTION: How is the school handling protecting staff and students? RESPONSE: Extra cleaning of high-touch areas, hand sanitizing when entering the building, ongoing cleaning of computers &amp; desks at the end of each class.</li> <li>QUESTION: Is public health coming to do COVID shots on site? RESPONSE: Parents will receive a waiver that they need to sign and send back as permission for students to receive a shot. *Only if there are more than 10 students requesting vaccination.</li> </ul>	10 mins
