Lead measures/Strategies

- 1. Continue to work under the "we are all learning support" model.
- 2. School staff leading professional development activities and workshops.

- 4. Identify a middle school leadership teacher and enhance student leadership.

Lead Measures/Strategies

- 1. Continue to have a consistent admin presence in classrooms and hallways in the school.
- 2. Implement a rush week that is student led focused on club creation.
- 3. Provide First Nations Metis and Inuit learning opportunities throughout the school year.
- 4. Provide staff team building and celebration opportunities throughout the school year.
- 5. Enhance learning support structures and services.
- 6. Student leadership will continue to lead assemblies and school activities.

LRSD Academics WIG

LRSD will increase the number of students achieving the acceptable standard in the following assessments by June 2026.

- → Cumulative PAT results will increase from 62.2% to 80% acceptable standard by June 2026.
- → Cumulative -1 DIP results will increase from 67.8% to 95% acceptable standard by June 2026.
- → Cumulative -2 DIP results will increase from 69.4% to 85% acceptable standard by June 2026.

FPW Academics Goal

FPW academics, as measured by the MRA, will increase from 67% to 70% by May 2024.

Lead Measures/Strategies

- 1. Student focused timetable construction.
- 2. Prioritizing hiring and retaining staff that align with our school vision/mission/motto.
- 3. Staff professional learning time will focus on differentiation and high impact pedagogy on student learning.
- 4. Staff professional learning is embedded into staff meetings and PLC time and driven by input from literacy and numeracy leads.
- 5. Continue with our "we are all learning support" model.
- 6. Provide a minimum of 2 teacher class observations (1/semester) from school administration including a pre and post meeting.
- 7. Continue to utilize a collaborative response model approach and begin to more purposefully utilize data including but not limited to: star reader, star math, class grades and a local social emotional survey to support students academic growth.
- 8. Develop an academic continuum of supports as a staff.
- 9. Provide debrief meetings for PAT and Diploma teachers along with professional learning release time and resources for growth.
- 10. Provide a minimum of 2 scheduled teacher/admin meetings to discuss teachers IPGP.
- 11. Provide intervention support for students in all academic subject areas on Fridays.
